Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 17th March 2026 commencing at 7.30pm in The Reading Room, Charlton Mackrell.

Councillors Present: Councillors, Susie Crang, Alan Crawley, Karen Rowland, Kim Williams and Joe Wooltorton. Councillor Wooltorton chaired the meeting.

A parishioner spoke in support of planning application 26/00445/HOU.

26/42 To receive any apologies for absence.

Following the last meeting of the Parish Council Councillor Katie Armstrong has resigned as a councillor for personal reasons. All other councillors were present.

26/43 To receive declarations of interests.

There were no declarations of interest.

26/44 To approve the minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on Tuesday 17th March 2026.

It was resolved to approve the minutes as a correct record of the meeting.

26/45 To comment on the following planning applications:

26/00445/HOU. Quarry Close, Station Road, Charlton Mackrell TA11 6AG. Demolition of existing prefabricated single story section of house and construction of new chalet bungalow style building in its place.

It was resolved to support the planning application as it will renovate a derelict building and enhance the street scene.

26/00583/LBC. Roselyn, Broad Street, Charlton Adam TA11 7AT. Proposed replacement gates, replacement of existing felt roof on garage with tiles and erection of a garden summer house.

It was resolved that the Parish Council has noted that there is no wildlife ecology survey included on the planning application, which is a requirement of the application form. If a wildlife ecology survey is not completed, then the Parish Council would object to this planning application.

26/46 To consider the payment of a fee of £500 to Somerset Council for them to provide detailed costings for the potential changing of speed limits in the parish from 30mph to 20mph.

It was resolved to pay the £500 fee.
